The gospel has advanced with both speed and effectiveness in places like Afghanistan, Nepal, North Korea, Syria, and Somalia. 

WE EXIST TO MAKE CHRIST KNOWN AMONG EVERY NATION, TRIBE, PEOPLE, AND LANGUAGE. WE ARE PREPARING A GENERATION OF GOSPEL WORKERS TO EMBRACE ADVERSITY AND OVERCOME BARRIERS TO GLORIFY THE KING.

At TRIAD, we are unapologetically focused on taking the gospel to the roughly 42% of the world who have never heard of Jesus—this includes individuals from over 7,000 unique people groups. The unreached have no Bible in their language, no believer to share the gospel with them, and no body of Christ to disciple them. As the world awaits the King coming to set all things right, TRIAD is working tirelessly alongside indigenous believers in the hardest-to-reach places to complete the Great Commission and hasten his return.

Our unique and strategic approach includes mobilizing, training, and deploying the global body of Christ and fueling indigenous-led work to ensure the gospel is shared among the hardest-to-reach places and people groups.

MOBILIZE

Our mobilization efforts compel the body of Christ to engage in his work among the nations. The Great Commission is the mandate of every believer. Our *Awaken* study—translated in several languages—is aligning the hearts of believers all over the world with God’s heart for those who have no eternal hope. Our advocacy efforts are stirring urgency among the Church toward fulfilling the Great Commission. And through coordinated worship and prayer events, the Holy Spirit is fanning the flame within believers to be disciple makers to the approximately 42% of the world who have never heard of Jesus.

TRAIN



WHY ARMENIA?

The Outpost is strategically positioned in Armenia, a Christian nation located in the gateway to the unreached world. This gives our team on the ground access to people from unreached nations every time they walk out their doors.

Armenia's status as a Christian nation and proximity to gospel-hostile nations provide a much safer location to facilitate critical training to Middle Eastern pastors and believers. This kind of training is an urgent need for churches on the frontlines as many of their pastors have been believers for less than a year.

Armenia is full of believers who have unparalleled access to nations closed to Western believers. Many of TRIAD's strategic initiatives are aimed at ushering these people into their prophetic destiny to reach the nations. Through war, tragedy, genocide, and occupation, God has preserved the nation of Armenia for such a time as this.

ARMENIAN REFUGEE CRISIS RESPONSE

In the fall of 2023, Azerbaijan annexed the contested territory of Artsakh, a majority Armenian populated region, through a series of aggressive actions. TRIAD stepped in to provide hope and support to the roughly 100,000 refugees fleeing the crisis.

MOBILIZE

Taking the gospel to every nation begins with mobilizing every believer to live on mission. Our team is awakening hearts to the plight of the unreached and the God who will stop at nothing to be known by all people.

ARMENIA

We are on mission to mobilize Armenian believers to take the gospel to the hardest-to-reach places. Closed to those of us in the West, these countries are open to Armenians, and many have existing Armenian communities already embedded.

AWAKEN CLASSES

We, along with our network of Armenian pastors, have been facilitating *Awaken* classes to engage believers in the oldest Christian nation with God's heart for the unreached.

Since its inception, God has been using believers in the United States to spawn some of the world's most prolific missions movements, and it still has a role to play. Through events, speaking engagements, vision trips, digital communication channels, and our *Awaken* Bible study, our US team is mobilizing hearts and recruiting resources to advance the gospel on the frontlines.



THE GOD WHO SPEAKS MY LANGUAGE

A major initiative of The Outpost is worship and prayer. Last year, our team hosted more than twenty worship and prayer gatherings. Our team is intentionally inclusive of the multi-ethnic environment in Armenia. Worship and prayer are offered up in three to five different languages from the stage.

Amil,* a young man visiting from a nearby Muslim nation, attended one of these gatherings. Here, Amil heard worship in his native language for the first time in his life. He was so moved by the experience that he came to the front of the room, fell on his face, and worshipped his creator for the first time in his life. He made a decision to follow Jesus that night.

The Holy Spirit was already at work in Amil's life before he even stepped into the room. However, Amil thought he would need to learn English to talk to the Christian God. He could not fathom a God who loved a Muslim boy so much as to speak to him in his native language. For the weeks that followed, Amil spent hours being discipled by our team at The Outpost. Many foundational concepts of Christianity were entirely foreign to him, and soon he would be returning home to a nation where being a



Christian is illegal—a nation with so few believers that it was unlikely that Amil would be able to connect with other believers or even find a Bible to read.

Despite these tremendous difficulties, Amil returned home and had soon shared his belief in Christ with his girlfriend and two other friends. Very recently, Amil was able to return to visit his extended family in Armenia with two of his friends who accepted Jesus because of his testimony. Once again, our team at The Outpost was able to spend hours discipling these young men, strengthening their faith in Jesus, and answering their questions.

EQUIP

This year, TRIAD's team in Armenia laid the groundwork for the fall 2024 launch of Equip. Our team is committed to raising up workers who are equipped for longevity in the harvest fields of the nations. Focused on developing a deep biblical foundation, personal resilience, and practical skills, Equip prepares those called to life in the field for the unique challenges of working among unreached people groups.

EMPOWER

Our first Empower intensive took place this summer, immersing five missions-minded young people to life in the field, God's heart for the unreached, and his call on their lives while serving alongside our staff in Armenia.

ON SEEKING JESUS AND FINDING HIM

When Equip launched in the fall of 2024 two of the seven participants were a husband and wife, Abdul* and Adina.* Not long ago, they left their home country, wanting some distance from the religious pressures they faced there. They moved to Armenia to open a restaurant. One of our team members met them in front of their restaurant as they were preparing to open. After promising to come by for a meal, the team member asked if she could pray for their business. They asked her if she was a Christian, and she said yes. They said they had been praying to meet a Christian and asked to be told about Jesus.

Through this encounter, they came to be followers of Jesus, and our team began to disciple them. Abdul and Adina immediately faced persecution from all sides—losing their restaurant because their investor did not want to work with Christians, emotional abuse and alienation from their families, and family members refusing to pay their debts, leaving Abdul on the hook for money he did not borrow because of his faith.

During the height of this persecution, though, Adina began to receive prophetic dreams from God. In these dreams, God taught her Scripture, comforted her, and revealed his name and nature to her. Guided by these dreams and through much prayer and seeking, Abdul and Adina responded to the call of God to spend their lives to make him known. Abdul and Adina have joined the inaugural class of Equip this fall to be trained up as workers for the harvest field.

DEPLOY

Workers FOR the most remote harvest Fields

Our team is preparing practically, relationally, and spiritually to send the most equipped workers into the most difficult harvest fields for the glory of Jesus among the nations. According to Nations Outreach, a staggering 47% of long-term missionaries leave the field after less than five years of ministry. We are committed to training and supporting gospel workers to remain in the field much longer so that they can begin to see the fruit of their labor.

LONGEVITY IN THE FIELD NEEDS

PROPER TRAINING

The importance of proper training for the field cannot be overstated, from the practical to the emotional to the spiritual, it is imperative that today's gospel workers are confident in the skills they need for being deployed.

PROPER STRUCTURE

Arriving in the field is not as simple as buying a plane ticket and landing in your country of choice. What kind of insurance is needed? What is the game plan for arriving and setting up life in-country—finding schools for children, living arrangements, a legitimate pretense for being there, visas and their renewals? How will the financial support be accessed once they arrive? Our deploy structure will ensure all of these questions are addressed and provide the necessary structure that many churches do not have in place for those who plan to spend their lives in the mission field.

PROPER SUPPORT

Many of the almost half of missionaries who leave the field early cited lack of support and connections from the home front as a prominent reason for leaving. TRIAD is a deploying partner, providing the training and structure, but we strongly believe that the local church is the sending partner. The spread of the gospel is the fruit of the local church. This is Christ's design; however, many local churches lack the understanding and resources to support gospel work in the field, long term. TRIAD's deploy mechanism will provide local churches with connections to the resources they need to be the long-term emotional support, spiritual covering, and financial resource for those they are sending to the field.




BLACKBOX

BLACKBOX is a special initiative of TRIAD created to partner, promote, and protect indigenous-led work among the hardest-to-reach places in the world. BLACKBOX prioritizes high Stratus countries—those facing the most urgent physical and spiritual needs. These countries fall predominately in the MENACA (Middle East, North Africa, and Central Asia) region. Concentrating our efforts where the need is greatest and opposition to the gospel most fierce, BLACKBOX is making disciples in the most difficult harvest field in the world.

Your partnership with TRIAD through BLACKBOX supports church planting, discipleship, leadership training, evangelism resources, humanitarian projects, creative access platforms, scripture translation, and mobilization—all critical elements in taking the gospel to the unreached.

BLACKBOX IS A SPECIAL INITIATIVE OF TRIAD

A STORY FROM NEPAL

Nested in the Himalayan mountains, days away from “civilization” lay many remote villages, ripe for the gospel. One group of Frontline Strategic Partners (FSPs) in Nepal are planting and nurturing small bodies of believers nested among these unreached villages. When the weather cooperates and the volatile mountain roads are passable, these FSPs travel from village to village checking in on new believers (some of whom are already taking on the role of pastor in their communities) and visiting and strengthening budding church communities.

In just six months of ministry last year, this FSP saw the baptism of 75 new believers, some of whom previously belonged to unreached people groups. Like a resilient plant clinging to a rocky outcropping, the gospel is taking root in the tough soil of Nepal where false religions have trapped people in darkness for millennia. God is working in and through the local church to establish his kingdom in the Himalayas.

Please pray for strength, safety, and encouragement for our partners on the ground in Nepal. Please pray that hearts would be more and more receptive to the message of the gospel. Pray for expanded freedom for our FSPs to share the gospel publicly in Nepal.

A STORY FROM AFGHANISTAN

To demonstrate the practical expression of the gospel taking place in Afghanistan, we'd like to share Malia's* story.

Malia was married off to a man in her village when she was very young. She quickly became pregnant and gave birth. Her baby was not breastfeeding well and was at risk for malnutrition and death. Lacking the knowledge and skills she needed to help her child, Malia asked her husband's permission to join a class being taught by our FSPs about nutrition and prenatal/postpartum care. In this course, Malia developed the skills she needed not just to keep her baby alive and see it thrive but to help many others in her village facing the same issues.


Malia told our team that her position in the village has been elevated, and the love between her and her husband has grown significantly as a result of her training. Women in Afghanistan face many challenges as second-class citizens, including lack of education, childhood marriage, lack of equality under the law, and many restrictions on personal freedom. Thanks to the work of our FSPs, Malia has been given dignity and influence in her community and a stronger relationship with her husband. And most importantly, She has also been exposed to the good news of Jesus.

Our FSPs in Afghanistan continue to check in with graduates of their courses both to assess how they are implementing their knowledge within their communities and to water the seeds of the gospel that are being scattered in the hearts of program graduates. By providing basic nutrition and medical training in remote villages, our partners on the ground are saving lives while creating inroads for the gospel to reach the most remote villages in Afghanistan.

Please be praying that this work will bear much fruit. Pray for the plight of women and young girls in Afghanistan whose lives and safety are often at risk due to cultural, political, and religious factors. Pray that the truth of the gospel will set free those sitting in oppressive darkness. And pray for the financial and human resources to expand this much-needed program to more villages in desperate need of basic medical care and eternal hope in Christ.



Our FSPs in the Middle East are using urgent needs like medical care, schooling, and refugee assistance as

a means to spread the gospel—even among remote people groups. Despite the threat of death, some have come to know Jesus and bravely proclaimed their new faith through baptism.

The North African region of the world faces many challenges. The harsh climate and arid weather create unpredictable agricultural outcomes and scarce resources. A history of war and occupation has led to internal turmoil and violence in these nations, and yet hope is on the rise in North Africa.

One of the direst needs the church of the unreached world faces is leadership. Church communities often need to remain small in order to avoid detection. Additionally, many communities are far from one another, and transportation is unreliable, necessitating more

pastors to reach remote locations. Our partners in North Africa are diligently and consistently recruiting and training pastors and leaders for the church on the ground in North Africa. These brave men and women are creating beachheads for the gospel in one of the world's most challenging environments as they proclaim the good news of Jesus to the poor.

A STORY FROM SOMALIA

Our Frontline Strategic Partners (FSPs) in Somalia are laboring diligently to train enough pastors and leaders to support the growing church in the region. To demonstrate this work, we'd like to share these words directly from our FSP.

"The scriptures describe David as one who shepherded his people with a heart of integrity and a skillful hand (Psalm 78:72). The church in the horn of Africa needs shepherds like David, integrity of heart and a skillful hand. The church in the horn of Africa is predominantly a first-generation church, and these first-generation believers need shepherding for them to bear fruit and bear fruit that will remain.

The shepherding task in the horn of Africa is of similar proportion as that of Titus in Crete. In Crete, Titus worked among a people described as liars, evil brutes, and lazy gluttons (Titus 1:12). The social dynamics within the horn are not far from fitting a similar description. First-generation believers in the horn of Africa, need to receive consistent sound biblical teachings so that they can be the aroma of Christ to their people.

The present reality is that more people in Somalia are responding to the gospel, and therefore more people need shepherds. Our most recent training raised 8 men who responded to God's call on their lives

by committing to collectively visit at least 30 brothers and sisters in the surrounding towns, every month, to offer them fellowship, teach sound doctrine, and to demonstrate brotherly love to them and their children."

Each time our brothers and sisters in Somalia coordinate or attend a pastoral training, they risk their lives and the safety of their families, but they do so to ensure that the seeds of the gospel taking root in Somalia will not be snatched up by the birds or choked out by thorns. Please pray for our brave brothers and sisters and for the seeds of the gospel to fall on good soil and bear much fruit.





REVENUE VS. EXPENSES





DEPLOY

Participants will join global strategists, field practitioners, trainers, innovators, supporting partners, and indigenous leaders from across the globe to pray and create action steps for bringing about the completion of the Great Commission—that every nation, tribe, people, and language would glorify the King together.



NEW BLACKBOX COUNTRIES

We are in the process of vetting and bringing on additional indigenous partners in two new nations. At BLACKBOX, we prioritize high-Stratus nations—countries that experience the deepest spiritual darkness and the direst physical needs—extending both hands of the gospel to those who need it most.




